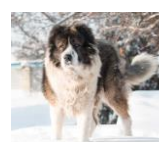
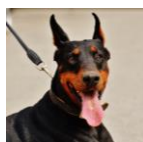


BREED GUIDELINES

Please be advised of our breed restrictions at WestJet Cargo. While we welcome most pets aboard, certain breeds, such as snub-nosed (brachycephalic) breeds, require special consideration. Our commitment to pet safety and comfort guides these restrictions, ensuring the best travel experience for all furry companions.

STRONG DOG BREEDS

- Strong breeds of dog can pose a hazard during handling and are more prone to breaking out of poorly constructed or incorrectly secured kennels.
 - Any strong breed **above the age of 6-months** must:
 1. Be transported in a CR-82 standard kennel;
 2. Can only be booked by an IPATA Registered Agent.
 - Strong breeds **under the age of 6-months**:
 1. Can be transported in a regular CR-1 standard kennel
 2. Can book directly with WestJet Cargo and without using an IPATA registered shipper, only on production of a document showing proof of age.
 - Pit-bull (all breeds) are restricted in Ontario.
 - Any mix of these dogs will be considered a strong breed.

BRACHYCEPHALIC BREEDS

- WestJet Cargo accepts brachycephalic breeds, pending veterinary health checks.
- From July 1st to September 15th, a complete embargo will be in place for these breeds due to high temperatures.
- WestJet Cargo reserves the right to decline transportation of brachycephalic breeds during times of reported high temperatures for the well-being of your pet

HAIRLESS BREEDS

- The shipping of hairless breeds of dog and cat is embargoed annually between 1st November and 31st March to avoid excessively cold weather.
- However, WestJet Cargo does allow approved shippers who have completed the Hairless Breed Waiver Form to move hairless breeds during the embargo. This waiver is only available to WestJet Cargo account holders; if approved, they will be entered into the list of approved shippers.

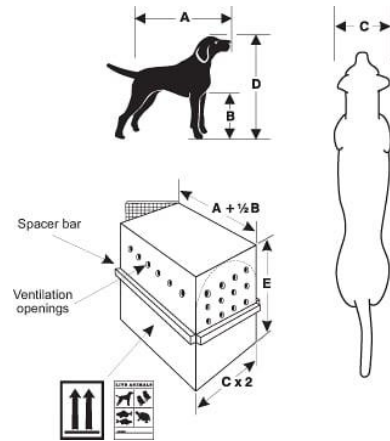

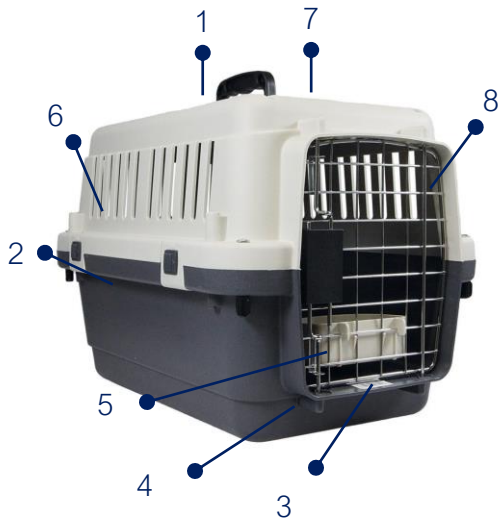
Rule of Thumb - The container must allow the animal(s) to stand up, turn around, and to lie in natural positioning

- A** = length of animal from tip of nose to base/root of tail
- B** = height from ground to elbow joint
- C** = width across shoulders or widest point (whichever is the greater)
- D** = height of animal in natural standing position from top of the head or the ear tip to the floor (whichever is higher)



Minimum internal container dimensions for a single animal:

$A + \frac{1}{2}B$ Length
 $C \times 2$ Width
 D Height



Typical CR-1 Compliant Container

1. Kennel must be clean with no offensive odors
2. Secure with no cracks or damages that risk the structural integrity of the kennel
3. If a container has wheels, they must be removed by the shipper.
4. Floor must be leak-proof and covered with a layer of absorbent non-consumable material (e.g., towels)
5. Water containers must be non-spillable with outside access for filling
6. Ventilation must be on all four sides total surface
7. Kennels with wire roofs are not allowed
8. One of end of the kennel be a metal grated door and nothing obstructing the ventilation of the door

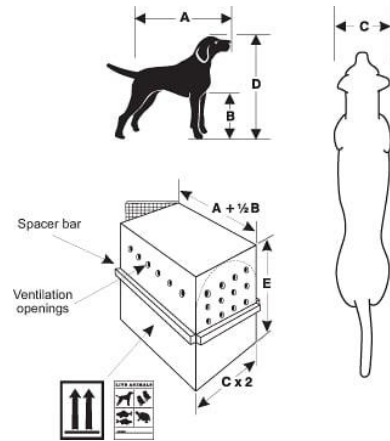

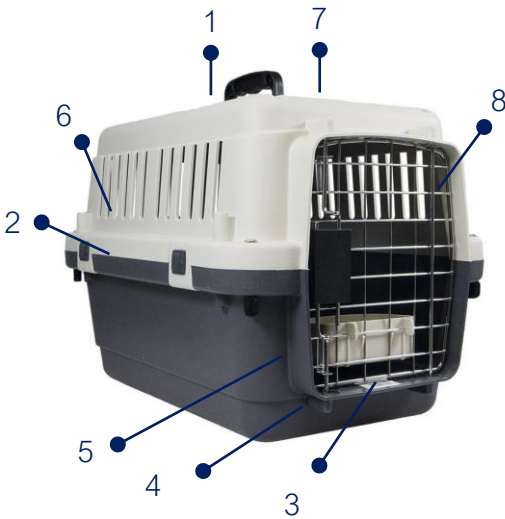
